

# Tech Data: Moldings

## Options

### Molding Materials and Finishes

- Solid Wood
- MDF / Particle Board
- Plastic laminate
- Stain or paint molding to match wood grain, sample, or laminate

## Doors and Panels

Moldings are milled and finished with stain, paint, or patterned material (square profile only) to meet specified design characteristics. Moldings are attached to components by mechanical and adhesive means. Doors and panels made with a variety of materials including laminate, phenolic solid surface, and wood veneer.

## Pilasters

Shoes are 22 gauge ASTM A-167 stainless steel with satin finish, not less than 3" in height.

## Door Hardware

Hinges are surface mount and strikes/keepers are wraparound style. Slide latches, coat hooks, and bumpers are surface mounted. Door pulls are through bolted. All fasteners are tamper proof.

## Brackets

Stirrup-type one ear, two-ear, and u-brackets are provided with theft resistant fasteners.

## Considerations

- Moldings may require additional cleaning care.
- Wood moldings are not guaranteed in wet areas.
- If used, interior panel moldings may interfere with toilet accessory mountings.
