



Beautiful Toilet Partitions Deserve Careful Installation

8 Common Installation Issues and How to Avoid Them


Labels Not Removed
Inspect all components and remove any remaining labels or peel coat before leaving.




Doors Upside Down
Watch the labels. They are placed toward the bottom for proper orientation.




Alcove Clips Not Level
Loosely fasten one side of the alcove clip. Level with a torpedo level, then install the second fastener. Tighten all fasteners.




Occupancy Indicator Misaligned
Set latch to fully open or closed. Confirm full green or red. Adjust as required.




Missing Headrail
The return headrail is not structural, but the stall looks unfinished without it. Install the return headrail.



Gap at Alcove
Layout alcoves on the floor before installation. Ensure the pilaster to panel gap is tight. Increase wall gaps if needed.



Missing Fasteners
Check brackets, headrail, shoes, hinges, latches, hooks, and bumpers for missing screws. Install missing fasteners as required.



Shoes not Secured
From the backside of the pilaster, drill through the shoe and secure with the provided fastener.
